Rules Change - PSC Meeting Reminder - Tuesday at 6:30 PM

The regularly scheduled membership meeting of the Poulsbo Sportsman Club will be held at 6:30 PM this coming Tuesday (November 6) in the club house.

On the agenda is a discussion and vote on a proposed change to the Standing Rules regarding criteria for membership vesting status. The current requirement is three years to become a vested member. Vested membership is required to hold an officer or board position and is required to vote in elections.

On October 30 the Executive Board approved a proposal to change the requirement from three years to one year. The next step for final approval is a vote by the membership.

The relevant section of our current standing rules with the proposed change in red:

Section 1- Membership,

6. Vested memberships are those Regular, Family, or Group memberships that have been maintained for a continuous twelve month period. ~~All new memberships beginning April 1, 2016, will be vested after 36 months of continuous membership.~~

- a. Vested Family or Group memberships are only allowed one vote in meetings, ballots and elections.
- b. A membership that is interrupted shall lose vested status until maintained for the required continuous period.
