

## Bremerton Brigade 2016

The Bremerton Brigade has continued to be active throughout the year. The Brigade has monthly shoots that are scheduled for the first Sunday of each month. The start time is at 0930 and access can be obtained through the gate on Innovative Way, off of Clear Creek Rd. The entrance (Innovative Way) is south the Poulsbo Sportsman's Club (PSC) gate, approximately 1/4 mile on the east side of the Clear Creek Rd.

There are some months later in the year that we may schedule a monthly shoot on a day other than the first Sunday due to hunting season or holidays. Be sure to check the PSC club calendar for changes.

The club has a special event on the first Saturday in June called Youth Day. This is a day for families to come out and shoot the primitive muzzle loader rifles, throw hawks, and shoot archery. There are games that kids can also play, and there are free hot dogs, drinks and chips for the families. We also have various camps set up for demonstration of primitive camping and some other exhibits that vary from year to year. The event is sponsored through grants provided by the Washington State Muzzle Loader Association.

The first weekend of August, we have a Primitive Rendezvous that people may also come out to shoot with us, using firearms that existed prior to 1840. People from the community are also welcome to merely come out and observe.
