

NOTICE of ELECTION for 2019 OFFICERS

Poulsbo Sportsman Club Elections are governed by Article II of the Poulsbo Sportsman Club By-laws and amended for efficiency by the Standing Rules, both are available in full in the members section of the website. The Slate of officers for election is below:

Election of the officers shall be by secret ballot at the annual membership meeting held in December, (Dec. 4, 2018). The terms of office shall begin on January 1, 2019.

Voting procedure is set by the club's Standing Rules, listed below in part:

Voting polls at the December annual meeting will open at noon and close 15 minutes before the start of the membership meeting.

The election committee will count the votes and present certified results to the Secretary, who shall read them as the last order of meeting business. The results without vote tallies will also be posted on the ranges and web site.

The President may appoint election judges, acceptable to the candidates, to observe the election process and ballot counting. The judges shall bring any voting discrepancies to the attention of the election committee for immediate action.

Absentee Ballot Process.

Vested members may request an absentee ballot from the Secretary.

The absentee ballot envelope must be marked 'Election Ballot' on the outside of the envelope and sent through postal mail to the club at P.O. Box 3651, Silverdale WA 98383.

An official ballot form is not required at this election, the member may note which of the nominated members he or she is casting the vote for. The ballot-letter should also include the member number.

Ballots not received by the start of the meeting on election night will not be counted.

The polling place will be the clubhouse.
