Club Elections Are Coming!

Club elections will be held at the December 1 membership meeting. The Nominating Committee (Doug Forsyth, Bill Bruce, and Woody Colyott) is working to present nominees for the following offices:

- President (Doug O'Connor is the incumbent)
- Vice President (Jeff Skoubo is the incumbent)
- At Large Director – Three year term (Warren Polensky is the incumbent)
- At Large Director – One year term (Woody Colyott is the incumbent but has chosen not to finish his term)
- Primitive Range Area Director (Gene DuVall is the incumbent)
- Rifle & Pistol Range Area Director (Larry Scott is the incumbent)
- Shotgun Range Area Director (Bill Bruce is the incumbent)

The Nominating Committee has to report a slate of candidates at the November 3 membership meeting. Nominations may also be made from the floor at the November meeting.

Service on the board is an important contribution to the life and well-being of the club. It involves a bit of work, but generally the workload isn't particularly heavy. As a board member, you're expected to attend monthly Executive Board meetings and monthly general membership meetings, and take part in committee work. The club's Treasurer will be selected from among the board members, as will the Secretary and Archivist. The Treasurer's workload is the heaviest, but should amount to a couple hours a week. The Secretary and Archivist functions should take only a couple hours a month.
