

Are you interested in serving on the PSC Executive Board?

Dear PSC Member,

It seems as if there is always an election for something these days – local, county, state, national, Sportsman Club.... Even though we had our 2017 election this past March, it's time to start planning for 2018. This election will be of particular importance as all Board positions except for 2 At-large Directors are open for election: President, Vice President, Shotgun Area Director, Rifle/Pistol Area Director, Primitive Area Director, one At-large Director, plus an additional 3 year term Director with the dedicated function of Treasurer. Elections will be held in the Clubhouse from 12:00 to 6:15 PM at the December 5th General Membership meeting.

Over the past few years, the Executive Board has overseen significant positive changes to the Club and Club operations:

1. Organized the financial management and processes to improve transparency and accountability and established professional relationships in law and accounting to maintain the changes. This is critically important to maintaining our not-for-profit status.
2. Trained the Executive Board on responsibilities of not-for-profit Board members to better understand and execute their responsibilities.
3. Established a positive relationship with the county and have maintained all required business licenses for operation.
4. Partnered with and sponsored a junior rifle team.
5. Purchased 38 acres on the east side of the shotgun range to further protect the Club from future development.
6. Received a FARR grant from the state to defray 2/3 of the costs of rebuilding the 50-yard range.
7. Replaced the baffles on the 15-yard range.
8. Added bullet deflectors on the 100 and 200-yard range to improve shooter safety and the longevity of the facility.

If you enjoy using the facilities, whether it's for shotgun, black powder, rifle or pistol and want them to be available in the future, consider a Board position. It is critical to our ongoing growth that the Club expands the pool of individuals interested in contributing. Nominations will be made by the Election Committee at the November Executive Board meeting. Candidates for all Board positions can provide biographies and relevant information for posting on the member's web site. The Board requests that all candidates for President provide the following information to be posted on the member's web site:

- What is their agenda for their term?
- How will they enable the Vision and Mission?
- What would they change and why?
- What would they keep the same and why?
