

**Section 4. Life Membership.** The Executive Board and Members may grant a Life Membership to a member who has rendered notable service to the Club upon the motion of one member, seconded by another, and by a three fourths vote at both an Executive Board meeting and a Membership meeting. A Life Member shall have all of the obligations of membership in the Club except payment of dues, and shall be entitled to all of the privileges.

**Section 5. Vested Membership.** Only vested members may vote in Club elections, ballots and meetings.

**Section 6. Maximum Membership.** The Executive Board may limit the total number of memberships.

## ARTICLE II - OFFICERS

### Section 1. Officers.

The officers of the Club shall be a President, a Vice President, a Past President Director, a Treasurer, three At-large Directors, and Shooting Range Area Directors representing the Shotgun Range Area, the Rifle/Pistol Range Area, and the Primitive Range Area. The Executive Board shall ~~elect officers to serve as Secretary and Archivist from among the members of the board~~ appoint individuals to serve as Secretary and Archivist from among members of the board or voluntary vested members.

**Section 2. Nomination Procedure, Time of Elections.** At the regular membership meeting held in October, a Nominating Committee of three members, including an At-large Director, shall be appointed by the President and confirmed by the Membership. It shall be the duty of this committee to nominate candidates for the offices to be filled. All nominations shall be presented by the election committee at the regular membership meeting held in November. Additional nominations from the floor shall be permitted at the November membership meeting. Election of the officers shall be at the annual membership meeting held in December.

**Section 3. Ballot Election, Removal from Office, Term of Office.** The Officers shall be elected by secret ballot of the membership held on the day of the annual Membership meeting in December. Officers may resign by sending notice to the Secretary, and may be removed from office at the pleasure of the membership as provided in the parliamentary authority. The term of office shall begin on January 1 and shall be as described below:

- a. The President shall serve a term of two (2) years or until a successor is elected. The immediate past President, after leaving office, may serve as Past President Director until the current President completes his/her term and fills that office.
- b. The Vice President shall serve a one (1) year term or until a successor is elected.
