Proposed Changes to the Bylaws and Standing Rules

The PSC Executive Board has approved proposed changes to our bylaws and standing rules with respect to the Treasurer position. Our 2016 treasurer resigned due to health reasons. After the most recent elections there is no one on the Executive Board with the skill set and time resources to perform the treasurer's job.

Currently the bylaws require the executive board to elect the treasurer from the members of the executive board. The proposed changes add a treasurer position elected by the membership to the executive board. This opens up the position to any of the vested members of the club. The addition of a position to the executive board is controlled by our articles of incorporation and requires votes at two monthly meetings to pass.

The first of two votes on the proposed bylaws changes will be at the June 6th membership meeting. The second vote on the proposed bylaws changes will be at the July 11th membership meeting (moved from July 4th due to the holiday) followed by the onetime vote on the proposed standing rules changes. A quorum is required to conduct business. Both of these meetings would be good to attend.

As a reminder for new members, you have to be a vested member to vote on bylaws changes. You become vested after three years of continuous membership. You are more than welcome to come participate in the discussions and see how things work.
