From NW Sportsman: "(You'll) pay between \$13.75 and \$17.57 more to fish, crab, and hunt in Washington under a 12 to 15 percent fee-increase proposal, one of two that WDFW put out for comment this week. The across-the-

board hike would raise the price of (your) combination fishing license, deer tag, and Puget Sound Dungeness, two-pole and Columbia River endorsements from \$132.55 a year to \$146.30 to \$150.12.
