

PSC Notes: for December 2013

Two Items of general interest were discussed at the November Executive Board meeting and are worth passing on.

First, you may have noticed that there has not been an update on progress on the Kitsap County range ordinance; an item that we have been working on for well over 18 months. Since the last update on June 12, there has been essentially no progress made. The wheels of progress have ground to a near halt over the issue of a noise study to be held at our club and KRRC. PSC's position remains that noise falls under the purview of the state but we have no objection to measurements at the club. As of this date we do not have a schedule for the study or a definitive outline of how it is to be carried out. At the beginning of 2014 Josh Brown will be replaced on the County Commission, which will add another uncertainty to the issue. And by the way, if you have an opportunity to thank Commissioner Brown for his support on this issue I hope you do so. He has been open to communication and has been helpful in our process.

At the EB meeting for November the board had a first discussion on potential agenda items for 2014. None of the items are detailed yet but all of them will be coming up for discussion. There will be many agenda discussions in the coming months but these along with our ordinance issues will be the critical items.
